

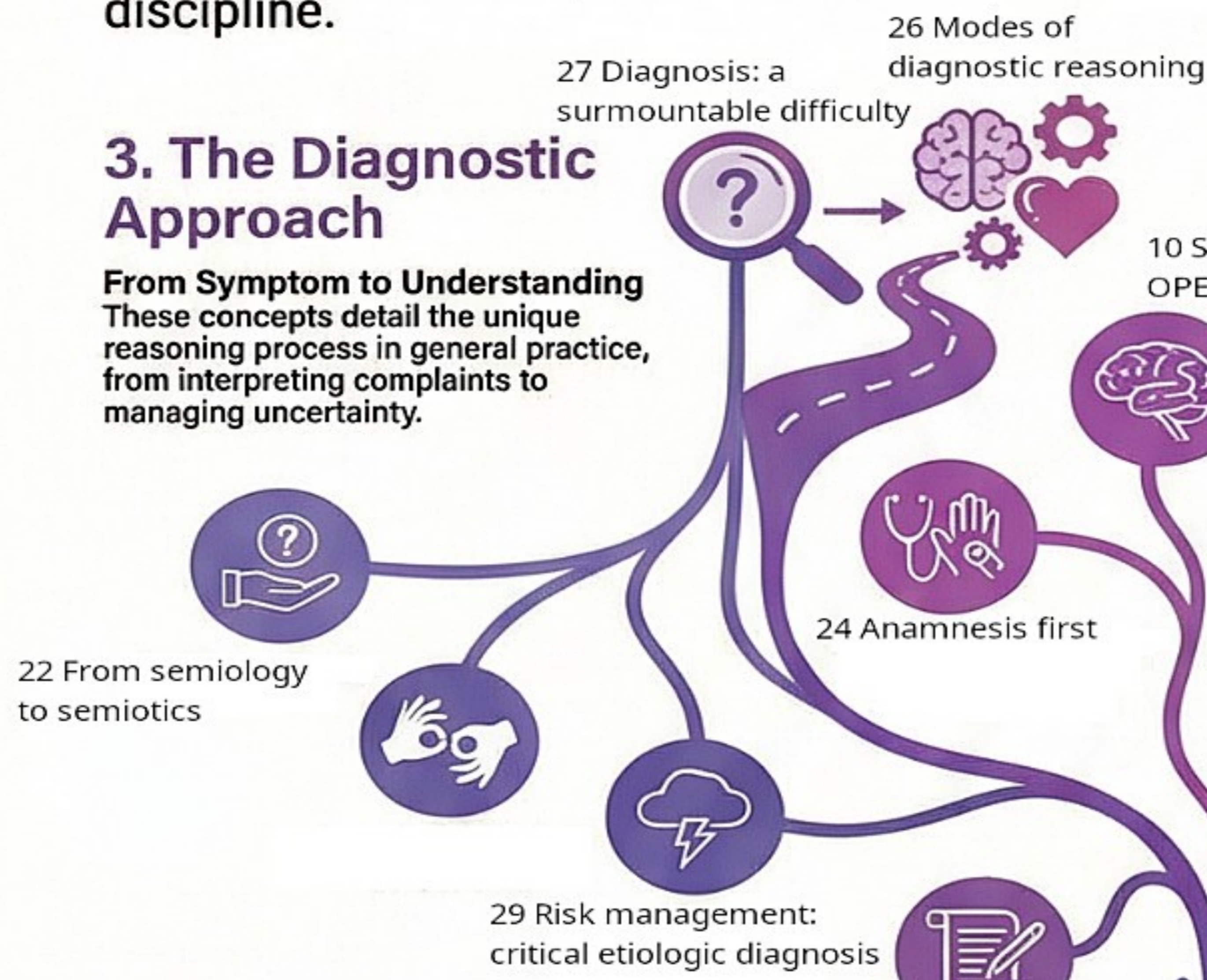
# The 41 Core Concepts of General Medicine

This infographic organizes the 41 core concepts that underpin its daily practice, research, and teaching, providing a comprehensive blueprint of the discipline.

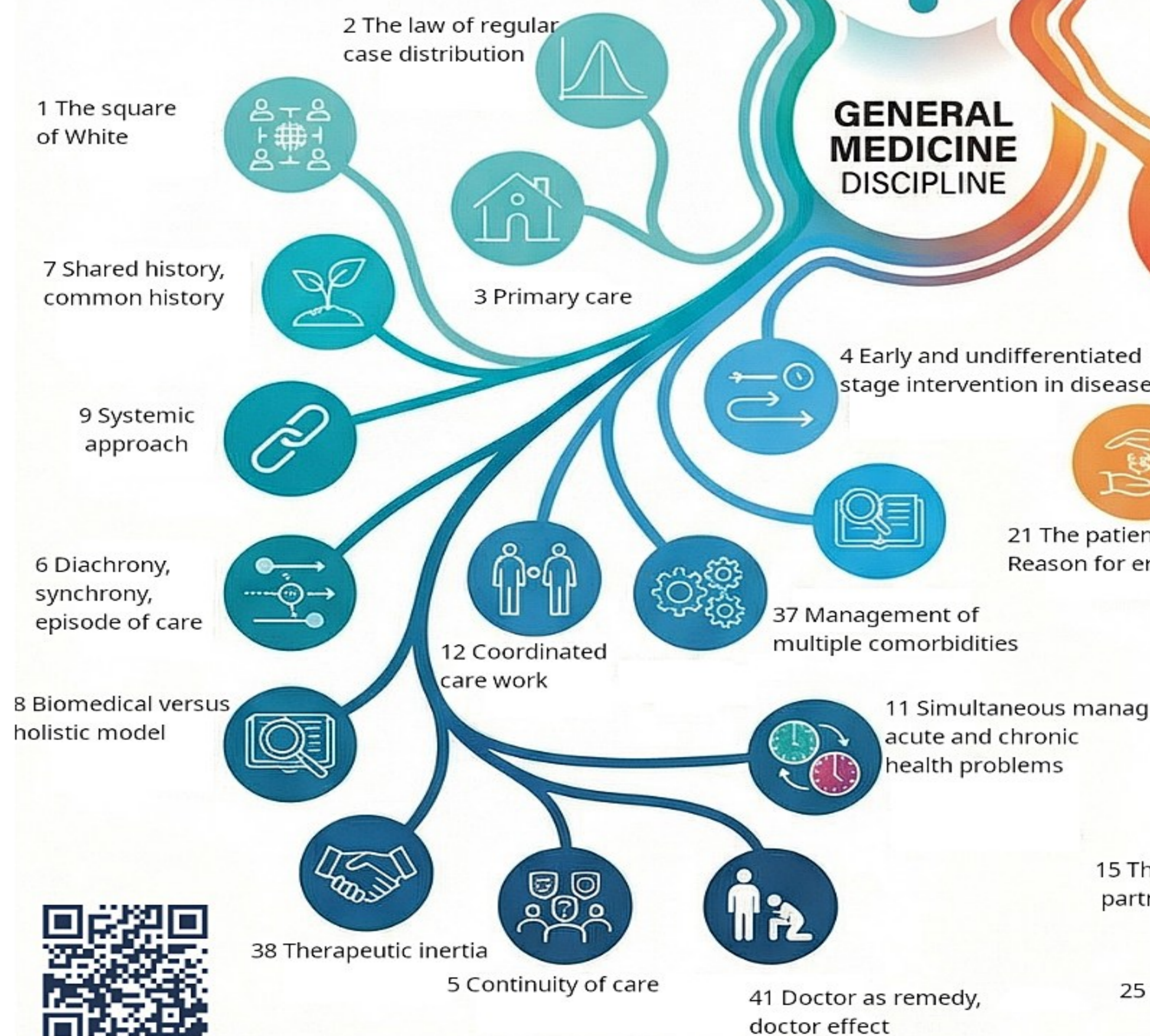

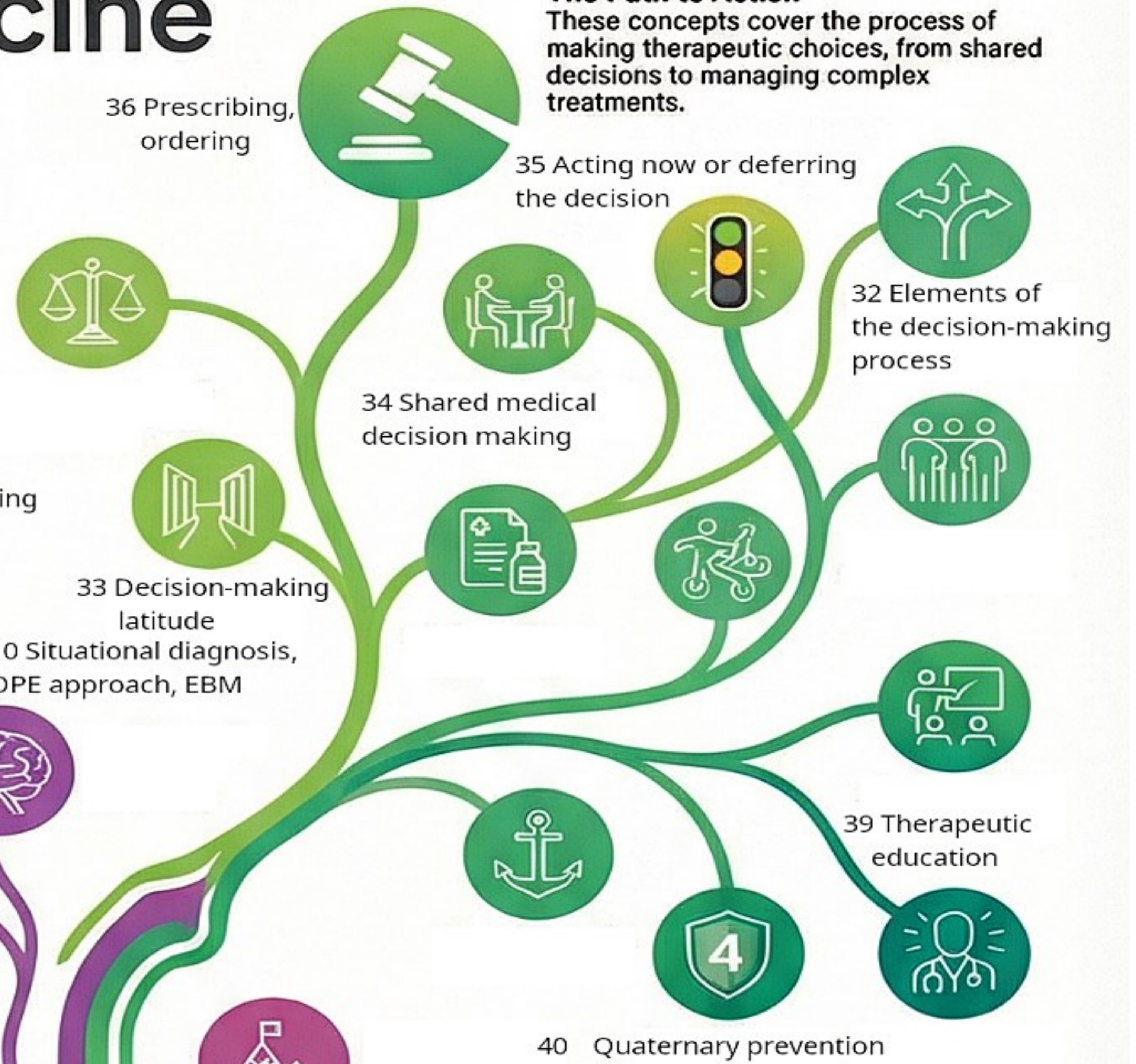
